8. Principals Report

Transitioning Grade 5 students from feeder schools, visited the schools with some peers, resource teachers & our counselor went to visit to find out more information about each students (likes etc).

Mon, Tuesday, Wed – Grade 5's came through for tours.

May 25th students will be able to take their parents for a tour through the school and have a meeting in the gymnasium.

June – invite the families of the students who are entering kindergarten in September 2023 to see how Stito:s needs to support each student.

Class placements are starting to get organized, middle school is a little more set than the Elementary grades (11 divisions elementary - # gr 6/7 #7 gr 7, #7 gr 8 classes)

Hiring more support staff as 3 positions have left as of end of June.

Hiring a few more temporary positions- they will get placed in positions (gr 4/5 & learning support and prep position)

23/24 SCHOOL YEAR- School Supplies- Elementary- asked for money and the school will be purchasing supplies for each student.

Middle school-receive a generic school supply list and then have specific supplies through specific teachers once classes are permanent.

Afford Fund- \$28 000 at beginning of the year- currently spend \$15 500- most around food security and some of the student's field trips, school clothes, & school supplies for students in need. Gift cards (GC) are the next on the list so the family can use them in. GC's purchased from Walmart (variety of options: school supplies, clothing, food, etc.) & GC's for the Servery- so students in need, aswell as any student is given a GC to help keep students connected without noticing food insecurities etc.

On June 15th admin will reassess to see the Fund balance & plans to purchase deodorant, mittens, clothes, needs for the students for the future.

4th Exploratory is moving forward for next year. (this year Stito:s had 3 exploratories 22/23 year- Food, Art & Woodwork) The 4th option/ course/ exploratory will all depend on the abilities of the new hire (new staff).

The Music teacher will be offering Music to all the grade 6's on top of Band program. (Mr. Kirkpatrick)

Robotics/Computer Skills learning program will hopefully be something they can offer in the future.

Bell Schedule will be changed slightly (possibly 10 minutes earlier)

Supervision availability will continue for before school, lunch (hope to hire another monitor) & afterschool.

Mrs. Issac (Gr 6) is retiring at the end of the year; Pac would like to give her a thank you card. (Mayra to purchase a retirement card and bring it to the next PAC meeting).
