All volunteers with the Chilliwack School District are required to complete a Vulnerable Police Information Check (PIC) through the Criminal Records Review Program (CRRP). These PIC's are effective for 5 years and there is no cost associated with the online form.



## Are You Moving?

As we begin preparations for the 2025-2026 academic year, it is essential that we have accurate enrollment information to support effective staffing and resource planning at **Stitó:s Lá:lém Totí:lt.**

If your family is planning to relocate and your child(ren) will **not be attending Stitó:s next year**, we kindly request that you notify the school office at your earliest convenience.

We encourage all students and families to take a moment to check the Lost & Found before the last day of school. It's a great opportunity to reunite with missing items before they're gone for good.


Please note: After the final day of school, all unclaimed items will be bundled up and donated to charity.
