Voting Item #1 Bylaws Section 5 - Term of Office, Point #5

The Immediate Past Chairperson may remain on the executive in an advisory capacity serve in an advisory role to ensure a smooth transition for one year.

The proposed amendment shall read as follows:

The immediate past chairperson may serve in an advisory role to ensure a smooth transition for one

Voting Item #2 Bylaws Section 6 - Executive Structure, **Expulsion of a Member**

This is a brand-new addition. There are no changes to be made to the previous addition.

1. A member may be expelled by a majority of not less than 75% of the votes cast by PAC Members at any general meeting. This can happen for any cause which the PAC may deem reasonable including engaging in activities that are against the Stitó:s PAC code of ethics.

Procedure:

- 1. Notice of Expulsion: The PAC shall give fourteen days written notice of such action to expel a member with a brief statement of the reason(s) for the proposed expulsion.
- 2. Appeal: An expelled member may appeal the expulsion, within 30 days.

Voting Item #3 Bylaws Section 6 – Executive Structure, **Expulsion of a Member**

All documents, records, minutes, correspondence, electronic access (login information, passwords, administration privileges, etc.) or other papers any property kept by a Mmember, executive member, representative, or committee member in connection with the Council PAC shall be deemed to the property of the Council PAC. and shall. The property shall be turned over to the chair with when the member, executive member, representative, or committee member ceases to perform the task duties to which the papers information relates. A Members duties conclude when they are expelled, resign, or at the end of the fiscal school year.

The proposed amendment shall read as follows:

All documents, records, minutes, correspondence, electronic access (login information, passwords, administration privileges, etc.) or any property kept by a Member, in connection with the PAC shall be deemed the property of the PAC. The property shall be turned over to the chair when the member, ceases to perform the duties to which the information relates. A Members duties conclude when they are expelled, resign, or at the end of the fiscal school year.
